Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004

Food contact legislation in Europe is implemented through the framework directive 1935/2004, "On materials and articles intended to come into contact with food and repealing Directives 80/590/EEC and 89/109/EEC". This framework directive covers the basic requirements for all food contact materials including specific legislation for plastic articles.

John Guest Ltd operates an ISO 9001 certified (British Standards Institute) Quality Manufacturing System. This system provides full traceability of food contact materials and articles during all stages of manufacture and distribution. In our opinion the Quality Management System in operation at John Guest satisfies the requirements of Regulation EC No 2023/2006, "On good manufacturing practice for materials and articles intended to come into contact with food".

Plastics in contact with food are required to meet the requirements of Regulation EU No 10/2011, "On plastics materials and articles intended to come into contact with food". John Guest's suppliers of plastics for food contact articles have advised that the monomers and additives used for the manufacture of these materials conform to Regulation EU No. 10/2011. Specific Migration Limits exist for some of these materials.
